Graduate Aptitude Test in Engineering (GATE) is a national level examination conducted every year by the prestigious IIT institutes. It's a great opportunity to for young graduates to pursue for further post-graduation courses and to be placed in PSU's

GATE exam is conducted for undergraduates from Engineering, Technology, Architecture and also Postgraduate level subjects in science.

Gate 2020 will be conducted for 25 streams (also referred to as "papers") and it will be conducted in the dates 2nd, 8th & 9th February.

The examination will be of online mode, Computer Based test (CBT) and it will be held in different cities across India, as well as six cities outside India.

Gate score will be valid for Three years from the date of announcement of the results.

Opportunities through GATE:

- With GATE score card you could get admissions in Master of engineering (M. E)/ Master of Technology (M.Tech) courses and PhD Programs at various IITs, NITs, GFTIs and other reupdated universities across India.
- GATE score also stands as a criterion to apply for prestigious jobs in PSUs, Government, GOI Organizations and Private Sector.
- on qualifying GATE, you could join state- level or a nations- level university/college for pursuing M.Tech, you also get a financial aid of 12400/- per month in the form of UGC scholarship for listed colleges in AICTE.
- Based on Gate score some renowned private companies shortlist candidates directly to personal interview.

How many times can we write GATE exam?

There is no limit for candidates to appear for GATE exam.

Can we give GATE exam in the 3rd year?

No, you cannot give GATE 2020 in 3rd year.

What is the eligibility for GATE exam?

To apply for GATE 2020, you should have BE/B.Tech/B.Pharma/B.Arch/B.Sc (Research)/B.S Professional Society Examination/M.Sc./M.A./MCA or equivalent/Integrated M.E/M.Tech/Integrated M.Sc./Integrated B.S-M.S/Integrated M.E./M.Tech or Dual Degree.

What is the age limit for GATE exam?

There is no age limit set for the candidates.

How many times the GATE exam is conducted in a year?

GATE is conducted once every year.

How much CGPA or percentage is required for GATE?

There is no minimum CGPA or percentage required to appear for GATE 2020.

Who conducted the Gate exam?

GATE exam is conducted jointly by IISc and 7 IITs on behalf of the National Coordination Board-GATE, Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Human Resource Development, GOI.
